Volunteering Roles







People who attend meetings but do not have a volunteer role are called self-advocates

This means that you will speak up for your thoughts and feelings at Asking You! meetings.

Self-Advocates do not have a job they have to do.

They can come to selfadvocacy meetings and have their say when they want to.

You will learn more about being a self-advocate and standing up for your rights.

You will also have the opportunity to come to regular meetings.

Elected Representatives



Elected Representatives will take views from People's Parliament to the Partnership Board meetings.

They will be voted in in the September People's Parliament. There are 3 roles.





You will have a pre meeting before each partnership board to prepare what you are going to say.

The role lasts for a year.

You can shadow an elected representative if you would like to go to the Partnership Board.

Stewards







Stewards help at Asking You! events.

This could be signing people in, getting people to and from taxis and telling people more about Asking You!

This could be at People's Parliament, Picnic in the Park or at stalls during Learning Disability Week.

There will be a meeting before each event to choose what job you would like to do.
