

People's Parliament Elections

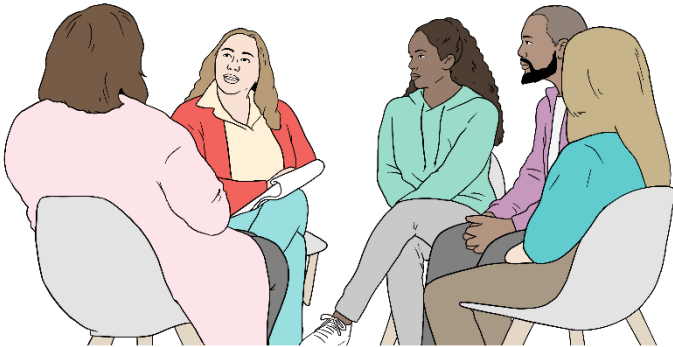


Each year we elect a volunteer role called 'Elected Representatives'.

To be an Elected Representative you need to:

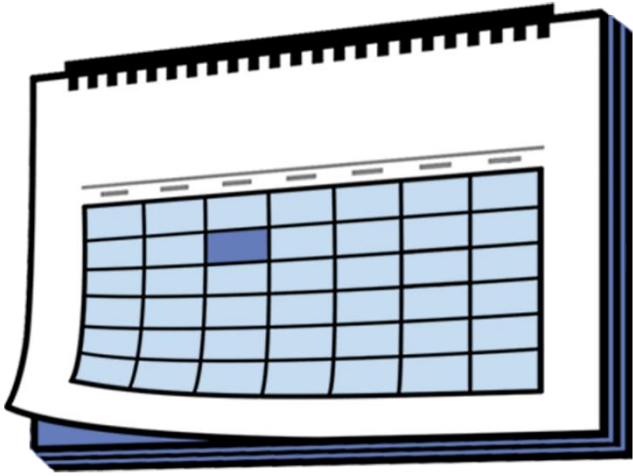
Be good at speaking to a large group of people

Elected Representatives will meet at different places, including The Advonet Group's office at 26 Roundhay Road.

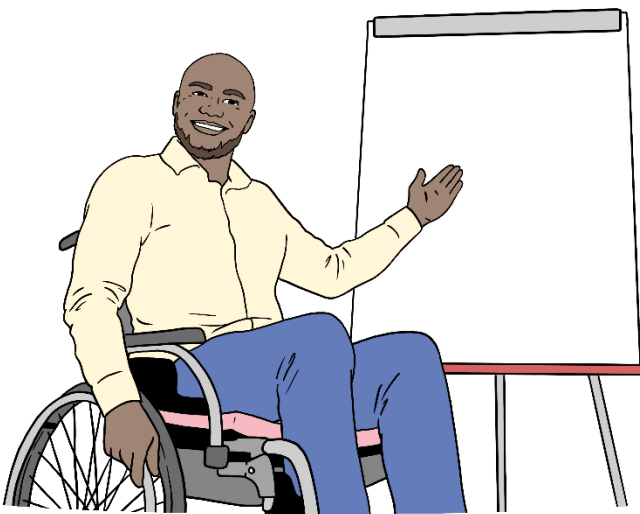
Some meetings will be online.

You will be part of important meetings about services for people with learning disabilities in Leeds.



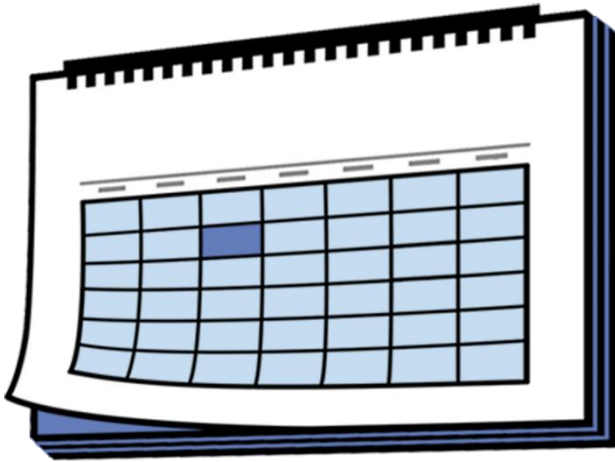
You can put this role on a CV when you apply for a paid role and Advonet will give you a reference.
